He can sit in the machine and rise thousands of feet, remain in the air for several hours and travel as much as sixty miles, without any engine. But gliding is dangerous, and many gliding airmen have been killed. Gliding could be carried out only when the wind was just right. The machine was never under real control. It was seen that if the glider could be fitted with an engine to pull it along fast enough, it could lift itself in the air.
